Chargefox expands EV charging access with addition of EVX kerbside plugs

Chargefox has partnered with EVX to bring hundreds more kerbside EV chargers to its national platform, boosting access for drivers without off-street parking and expanding Australia's most comprehensive EV charging network.

EVX chargers are currently situated at various locations in New South Wales, including Wollongong and Sydney, as well as Ballina and Byron Bay. There are also 2 locations in the south-eastern suburbs of Melbourne.

This announcement comes shortly after the addition to Chargefox of AGL kerbside charging sites, further demonstrating the commitment and collaboration of the EV charging sector to those without an at-home charging option.
