

The Safe Havens platform is infused with Artificial Intelligence (AI) via OutSystems Machine Learning Builder and Microsoft Azure¹. It also features internal chat services with sentiment analysis overlay, and high-quality mobile experiences first authored in OutSystems' Experience Builder.

As the Children's Guardian Amendment (Child Safe Scheme) Bill 2021 (Bill) has moved through NSW Parliament it creates a regulatory framework requiring relevant organisations in NSW to comply with new strict 'Child Safe' standards. To enhance support for organisations that need to comply with these obligations, new 'Child Safe' deployment and performance assessment features are being introduced to the Safe Havens platform.

Social logins, such as Google, Facebook and or Apple complement 2nd level authentication with one-time passwords to manage and secure student and community access. General access is strictly controlled with an integrated compliance layer to ensure users maintain external WWCC certifications, and personal audit checks to control access rights.

"The release of the new Safe Havens Sentinel V2 is a major step forward in addressing Australia's considerable challenge to significantly reduce child abuse and neglect. With its flexible design, this release enables organisations to build capabilities that are child-safe across hundreds of locations while monitoring what's going on at any given moment - all from one system," said John Ackery, the Safe Havens team.
