## **Australia's Chief Scientist, Dr Cathy Foley and Saul Griffith to Speak at Largest Climate Technology Event**

On December 7th, 2022, Sydney, will host the largest climate technology event in the southern hemisphere. The 2022 Climate Technology Festival, produced by Climate Salad, brings together more than 50 companies, 50 investors and over 300 supporters at the Maritime Museum in Sydney.
