Medicinal Cannabis – Humboldt Seed Co. lands in Australia

Biortica Agrimed's wholly owned subsidiary Apollo Green, Canada has partnered with California's renowned Humboldt Seed Company to bring 8 of its highest performing medicinal cannabis varieties to Australian growers.

OG and *Donutz* triploids together with industry leaders including *Blueberry Muffin*, *All Gas OG*, boasting 21% THC content, and the high – 30-35% THC - yielding varieties *Golden Sands*, *Guzzlerz*, *Jelly Donutz* and *Orange Creampop*.

Established in 2001, and world renowned as a specialised medicinal cannabis seed breeder, these strains represent the top performing 0.1% of Humboldt Seed Company's range. Hand-selected, the varieties were identified after many years of implementing a structured and extensive pheno-hunting program.

Export from Apollo Green commences this month under its' Canadian Federal cannabis license being certified to meet all phytosanitary requirements. Australian growers can contact Biortica Agrimed now.
