Perth, Australia – July 10, 2025 — Indie-pop newcomer Hannah Stow drops a hauntingly catchy new single, Toxic Teddy Bear, a brutally honest anthem about masking toxic behavior behind the soft blanket of self-improvement.

"It's about weaponizing softness," Hannah Stow says. "You can say all the right things, act like you've done the work — but no amount of self help podcasts or books will hide actions that are clear as day. This song holds a mirror to that."

With hypnotic guitar riffs, layered harmonies, and lyrics that teeter between vulnerability and manipulation, Toxic Teddy Bear is both an emotional gut-punch and a tongue-in-cheek take on modern accountability culture.

Following a string of well-received releases this year, Hannah is set to perform at **Perth's**Milk Bar on August 8, and will open for AVIVA this October, further solidifying her growing presence in the Indie-pop scene.
