Shifting gears, "Joy in the Journey" stands out as an upbeat, toe-tapping track about embracing the present. The EP concludes with "These Are the Good Old Days", a nostalgic anthem that synthesises the themes of the EP and leaves listeners ready to experience the journey all over again.
